The Wilmington Legal Division sells law related information, education and networking opportunities to two groups of customers:


- Law professionals this includes solicitors, barristers, paralegals and those that work in legal services organisations



Best Interest Assessor (BIA) Legal Update / Refresher training

The training

The interpretation of the legal framework through recent case law will be explored, and the implications these have in daily practice.
